PE for Butterflies

The Butterflies have thoroughly enjoyed taking their physical development learning into the school hall on Mondays. They have demonstrated how they can find a magic space to stay safe, they are able to take off their shoes and socks and keep them safely in a pair under the bench, and they have started to learn about what happens to their hearts when they do exercise.

Please practise putting on shoes and socks at home so that your child can manage this independently. Children often struggle with how to put their socks the correct way if they are inside out. Show your child how to do this at home and practise together.

Library

Your child MUST have a school book bag in Nursery on their library day if they would like to bring a library book home. Library days are Tuesday if your child is in Nursery on this day, or Friday if not.

Disabled Parking Space in the Staff Car Park

The car park outside of the Nursery is a staff car park and is only for staff cars, families using a blue badge or for school transport taxis. It is not for any Nursery families or school families to use at drop off or pick up times. Please remember this when you are dropping your child at Nursery or picking them up.

We do have families within the school and Nursery with a blue badge that need access to the disabled parking space at drop off and pick up times. You **must** make sure that you **do not block the entrance to the car park or this space** to allow easy access for families using the space to park.

Wellington Boots and Wet Weather Trousers/Puddle Suits

Please make sure your child has a **pair of named wellies, a pair of waterproof trousers and a waterproof jacket that will be kept at Nursery**. These are essential and are needed on a daily basis for learning outside.
