- Use google to find the flag for China and to see pictures of the Great Wall of China.



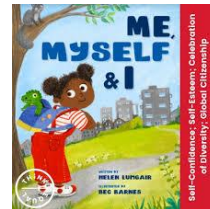
Below there are two words. Please say these words to your child, find out if they know what they mean and talk about their meaning together.
