WHAT HAPPENS AFTER?

The tests are sent away and marked externally.

Scores arrive back to school and are shared along with other assessment data with the end of year report.

Children will get a 'scaled score' of their results

100+ = age expectancy 110+ = greater depth

In school, we then focus on writing and submitting teacher assessment grades.
