Google Classroom	https://classroom.google.com	This platform will be used to assign tasks and activities for the children to complete. Teachers will respond to work sent in through this platform. Google meets will be used within Google Classroom to for teachers to host and children to participate in whole class live lessons
Zoom	https://zoom.us/	This will be used to deliver 1:1 and small group sessions with children who would normally receive 1:1 or small group support as part of their normal learning within school. Details of IDs and passcodes will be sent to a child's parent directly should this be required. Sessions will be recorded for future reference should the need arise
Microsoft Teams	https://teams.microsoft.com/	Microsoft Teams will mostly be used by our SEND agency professionals who work with individual children and deliver therapy sessions and meet with parents and staff.
Mathletics	https://www.mathletics.com/uk/	Mathletics provides learners with the chance to put their mathematics skills to use through activities and challenges that are relevant and attention-grabbing. Teachers may set specific assignments or the children can work through the challenges at their own pace. The challenge is to gain a Bronze award once a week. If a child is struggling with a concept there is an easier version to click on to until they have gained a greater understanding and are feeling more confident.
